



GEORGE ROBERTS FARM

This fine old Cape Cod cottage was built over a hundred years ago. A part of the farm on which it stands was the home of the Rev. Isaac Cushman. A Chandler family is said to have lived here, also Avery Dean. William Henry Leander Wright lived here around the 1850's. Around 1890 George Roberts bought the farm. Around 1900 his son George E. Roberts inherited the place. Here he lived until his death in 19 . The lady standing in front of the house is Helen Briggs Roberts. In 1907 her brother Jerome Briggs completely remodeled the buildings, after which it acquired the name Jerome Cottage. Charles Northrup is the present owner and occupant.
