I EARLY NORTH SCHOOL HOUSE

This was the building of District No.1.It was destroyed by fire in I

2 LAST NORTH SCHOOL HOUSE

It was located on the southeast corner formed by the junction of Main St.and County Road.It was often called the Bell School after the Ladies' Memorial Society had equipped it with a rather large brass bell.This spot is also the site of a stage caach tavern which was destroyed by fire around the middle of the last century.

3 EARLY GATE SCHOOL

4 LAST GATE SCHOOL

Officially known as District No.2.Used for school sessions up to and including 1889.

5 ALFRED CHURCHILL FARM

6 EARLY NECK SCHOOL

It stood on the southeast corner of the Edward S.Sherman farm.That is the part of the farm north of Center Street.

7 LAST NECK SCHOOL

It was located on Cross Road a short distance south from the Joseph Sherman farm and on the opposite side of the road.Officially it was the building for District No.6.

8 EARLY FACTORY SCHOOL

9 LAST FACTORY SCHOOL

It was the building for District No.5,and was last used for school sessions in 18

10 WASHBURN HALL

The upper story was used for a dance hall and the lower part as a factory in which boxes and coffins were made.

II JOSIAH WRIGHT FARM

12 ADAM WRIGHT HOUSE

13 ELLIS HALL

Located on the now named Mayflower Road.
It was used for an armory and town meetings.

14 PARKER FIELD

Plympton base ball teams used this field
for their home games between 1890 and 1903.
It was the property of Z.T.Parker at the time.

15 TATTLE STREET SCHOOL

It was the building for District No.3, and
was last used for school purposes in 18

16 WARREN FULLER FARM

17 BENJAMIN BRYANT FARM

18 BOSWORTH FARM

19 TOWN POUND ^{question}

Located on the now named Elm Street and in
use around 1800 and likely much before that
time and considerably later.

20 EARLY BASE BALL FIELD

Located opposite the house of the late
Charles and Irving Morse. Very likely the
traditionally famous Winnatuxet-King Philip
game was played here.
