Attendees: Joseph A. Freitas, John P. Henry, and Barry DeCristofano  
Meeting called to order at 7:00 PM

Appointment: 7:00 PM Marylouise Sayles. Ms. Sayles read a letter to the Selectmen regarding the Learning to Ride Center at 97 County Road in Plympton.

Ms. Sayles reported that on May 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup>, Saturday and Sunday that the noise from the ATV's and dirt bikes was unbearable. Ms. Sayles also wanted to know if the Planet Dirt Bike Trailer was a permanent fixture on the property.

Mr. Karling and Mr. Richards informed Ms. Sayles and the Selectmen that the State of Massachusetts Registry of Motor Vehicles issued the license under the "Educational" use provision to the Learn to Ride Center.

The Selectmen advised Ms. Sayles to contact the Registry of Motor Vehicles, the Board of Health, and the Police Department. Ms. Sayles will keep the Selectmen up to date with her findings.

**VOTED:** Motion made by Mr. Freitas to appoint Mr. Henry as the voting representative to the eighteen Town Task Force. Second Mr. DeCristofano. 3-0-0.

Mr. Henry will obtain the draft copy of the Transfer Station Contract and give to Mr. DeCristofano.
