

PLYMPTON BOARD OF SELECTMEN  
MINUTES  
June 23, 2008

Attendees: Joseph A. Freitas and John P. Henry.  
Absent: Barry DeCristofano.  
Meeting called to order at 7:00 PM

Mr. Sean Tripp asked the Selectmen about an appeal for his dog, Knuckles. Mr. Freitas suggested that Mr. Tripp contact obtain legal counsel; call the Attorney Generals Office or the District Attorneys Office.

7:05 PM Ambulance Billing Committee members, Fire Chief David Rich and Town Accountant Barbara Gomez presented an excel sheet with fifteen accounts totaling \$8,311.00 and requested a "hardship right off."

**VOTED:** Motion made by Chief Rich to write off 15 accounts for a total of \$8,311.00 as "hardship cases." Second Mr. Freitas. Unanimous.

Chief Rich reported that the Fire Department received a grant in the amount of \$49,000.00. He asked the Selectmen to approve of the disposal of thirty sets of 1998 obsolete fire jackets, boots and other gear.

**VOTED:** Motion made by Mr. Freitas to dispose of the obsolete fire gear as Chief Rich suggests. Second Mr. Henry. 2-0-0.

7:15 PM Mr. Randall submitted his earth removal fee of \$870.90 and renewal gravel permit Fee of \$50.00 for "Off Ring Road," The Hayward, Company, LLC.

**VOTED:** Motion made by Mr. Henry to approve the gravel renewal permit for the site "Off Ring Road," expiration date of October twenty four, 2008. Second Mr. Freitas. 2-0-0.

7:20 PM Jon Wilhelmsen gave an update for the Historical Commission regarding signs. Placement will be: the Cemetery. Sign to include a brief history and town web site. Harrabs Corner, and a Historical District Sign in Town. Mr. Wilhelmsen will check town by-law regarding legal placement.

Finance Committee Chair, Jacki Norrie announced meeting with the Board of Selectmen had to be postponed due to "no quorum."

7:35 PM Mr. Smith submitted a bond and \$50.00 check for a gravel renewal permit for R&M Realty Trust at 181 Brook Street.

**VOTED:** Motion made by Mr. Henry to renew gravel permit to Mr. Smith with an expiration date of September 18, 2008. Second Mr. Freitas. 2-0-0.

**VOTED:** Motion made by Mr. Henry to appoint Police Chief Matthew Clancy as Town Liquor Agent. Second Mr. Freitas. 2-0-0.

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Mr. Freitas thanked the Old Home Day Committee and the Upland Club members for a wonderful time on June 21, 2008 at the Old Home Day festivities.

Mr. Henry gave a brief update of the Executive Session # 6 meeting that took place on June 23, 2008 at 10:00 AM. Mr. Henry said an Executive from Plymouth Rocks Studio and their real estate attorney are interested in the Industrial Park site. The Selectmen will be notified within the next two weeks. More information to follow.

Mr. John Leschen gave an update on the Casino. The regulations have gone into effect on the Casino. There are more hurdles for the Mashpee Tribe: There is a twenty five mile radius from the Government Seat. The connection to historical land is difficult to establish a modern connection.

**VOTED:** Motion made by Mr. Freitas to submit a letter to Robert Karling stating there is no money in the street light account until July 01, 2003 to pay the street light accounts. Second Mr. Henry. 2-0-0.

The Selectmen will request an up date on the Town light report from Mr. Karling

Mr. Freitas reported that he will find out more facts regarding the Conservation Commissions request to reduce members from seven to five members.
