

PLYMPTON BOARD OF SELECTMEN
MINUTES
August 25, 2008

Attendees: Joseph A. Freitas, John P. Henry, and Barry DeCristofano
Meeting called to order at 7:25 PM.

VOTED: Motion made by Mr. DeCristofano to appoint Colleen Thompson to the Community Preservation Committee until June 30, 2011. Second Mr. Henry. 3-0-0.

7:30 PM Appointment: Mr. Young Kang – expansion permit for Plympton Convenience & Liquor Store at 286 Main Street, Plympton, MA 02367.

There was much discussion with the Town's residents during the meeting. Topics of concern for the Selectmen were:

- Violations of liquor license in past.
- There is no need for a larger liquor store in town.
- The well is not protected.
- A protection plan for the well from an Engineer was recommended.
- The Occupancy Permit that was issued was for storage of non alcoholic items.

Mr. Kang stated the Department of Environmental Protection agents would not accept his phone calls due to the fact that the property had been under a previous owner. Mr. Kang informed the Board that he has hired an Engineer and that he spoke with the Town's Planning Chairman, Jack O'Leary regarding the landscaping at the property. Mr. Kang reported that a letter from the Planning Board will be sent to the Board of Selectmen.

VOTED: Motion made by Mr. Henry to deny the expansion permit of Mr. Young Kang. Second Mr. DeCristofano. Mr. Freitas is against motion. 2-1-0.
