

PLYMPTON BOARD OF SELECTMEN
MINUTES
September 08, 2008

Attendees: Joseph A. Freitas and Barry DeCristofano.

Absent: John P. Henry Meeting called to order at 7:00 PM.

7:00 PM Continuation of Gravel Permit for R. Correira was postponed until next Board of Selectmen meeting on September 15, 2008.

Mr. Freitas and Mr. DeCristofano signed the State Primary Warrant for the Town Clerk, Nancy Butler.

Mr. Freitas reported that a letter will be sent to Ms. Anderson and Mr. Turkeli at 277 Main Street, Plympton, MA 02367 regarding the removal of the existing building; with a dead-line completion date by October 01, 2008.

Mr. DeCristofano reported that he has reviewed the Town Communication report by Ms. Kimberly Lawrence and has passed the report onto Mr. Henry. Mr. DeCristofano stated that the Communication report outlines short and long term goals for the Town. Ms. Lawrence recommended a "point person" and a separate Committee be appointed to a Communication Committee for the Town. Once the Selectmen have reviewed the Communication report, a meeting with the Selectmen, Ms. Lawrence and the Web Committee will be scheduled.
