September 15, 2008

Meeting called to order at 7:00 PM.

**7:00 PM** Roger Correira - Continuation of Gravel Permit hearing. Mr. Freitas reported that all of the Selectmen visited the proposed bog site at "0 Ring Road," Plympton, MA.

**VOTED:** Motion made by Mr. DeCristofano to grant the gravel permit to Mr. Correira with two conditions: 1. Work will not start until the Order of Conditions is issued. 2. Mr. Correira submits a Bond. Second Mr. Henry. 3-0-0.

**7:30 PM** Officer Patrick Dillon, Union President for Town of Plympton Police Department, Officer Robert Costa, Officer Scott Petersen, and Officer Dana Fowler.  
Officer Peterson reviewed the present policy and salary for Traffic Detail Officers versus State regulated Flag Men/Women road Details. Officer Peterson made a request that the Selectmen respond to the State Department before the deadline of October 03, 2008.  
Mr. Freitas stated that he take the matter under advisement and will contact Police Chief, Matthew Clancy and report back to the Board and Officer Dillon at the next Board of Selectmen Meeting on September 22, 2008.

**7:45 PM** Library Director, Debbie Batson and Library Trustees. Ms. Batson gave an overview of the recent flood watch in the Library basement due to Hurricane Hanna. Mr. DeCristofano reported that he was notified and joined the flood watch. The Library Trustees, Ms. Batson, and the Selectmen discussed some of the roles, duties, and responsibilities' since the dissolve of

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(TOPLA – July 02, 2008) Town of Plympton Library Association.

Mr. Freitas asked about the Library budget, heating system, and responsibility of janitorial duties. Discussion of FY2010 Warrant Articles for Library repairs and the Endowment Trust interest income for repairs ensued. It was decided that Mr. DeCristofano will be notified of any problems that may arise to the building structure, interior, exterior, and grounds until further notice of the Selectmen.

**8:00 PM** Lisa Hart – Conflict of Interest Laws. Ms. Hart requested that the Selectmen approve and sign a disclosure of financial interest by Municipal Employee certification in order that she may accept employment at the Town Library while remaining a member of the Finance Committee.

**VOTED:** Motion made by Mr. Henry to permit Ms. Hart to work as a Municipal Employee of the Town with ten to twenty hours per week without benefits. Second Mr. DeCristofano 3-0-0.

**VOTED:** Motion made by Mr. DeCristofano to appoint Polly Nordhal to the Council on Aging until June 30, 2011. Second Mr. Henry. 3-0-0.

**VOTED:** Motion made by Mr. DeCristofano to appoint Polly Nordhal to the Community Preservation Committee (designee for the Council on Aging.) Second Mr. Henry. 3-0-0.

Mr. Henry reported that he has been in contact with Town Counsel regarding the October 15, 2008 hearing of Mr. Young Kang.

Mr. Henry reported that the ETA is not complete and is waiting for a response from Kingston Officials. He stated that joining with Wareham/Carver ETA may be a possibility.

**VOTED:** Motion made by Mr. Freitas to adjourn meeting at 8:45 pm to review Minutes of the August 25, 2008 Meeting. Second Mr. Henry. 3-0-0.

**VOTED:** Motion made by Mr. DeCristofano to accept the Minutes of the August 25, 2008 with correction to page one, second vote, to read “Mr. Freitas is against motion 2-1-0.” Second Mr. Henry. 3-0-0.
