

PLYMPTON BOARD OF SELECTMEN  
MINUTES  
September 29, 2008

Attendees: Joe Freitas, John Henry, and Barry DeCristofano

Meeting called to order at 7:25 pm.

Met with the Highway Surveyor and the Chairman of the Board of Health regarding non-stickered use of the recycling bins at the Transfer Station. It was agreed that now that the Town is getting money for our recyclables, it should be okay to allow anyone to bring their materials there. For now, the attendants will just allow it and when the improvements are made to the site, traffic flow will more easily allow such use without non-stickered cars getting near the trash bins.

The sticker fees for next year were agreed upon. They will be \$150 per resident, \$50 for seniors (65 years of age and older), and will be pro rated for people coming in mid-year. They will be sold at the Town Barn. There was also some discussion about issuing 2-year stickers.

The Selectmen are still working on getting gas heating into the Town House for the Town Clerk's office to cut down on our heating expense.

The condition of the Library building was discussed (gutters, dry wells, water in the basement, etc.) and the scope of the repairs will be defined prior to deciding on a course of action.

The Board signed a lighting agreement with NSTAR to add and repair 5 street lights in town.

A Class II auto sales license was issued to Mr. Beliveau at 376 Main Street.

The Highway Surveyor's request to apply for Chapter 90 reimbursement was approved (3-0-0) and signed.

On a motion by Mr. Henry and a second by Mr. DeCristofano, it was voted to appoint Mr. Freitas as a signatory on the Old Colony Metropolitan Planning Organization.

At 8:28 p.m. on the motion of Mr. Henry and a second by Mr. DeCristofano, the Board entered Executive Session for the purpose of discussing strategy with respect to ongoing litigation (Purpose #3). Roll call vote: Mr. Freitas – yes, Mr. Henry – yes, and Mr. DeCristofano – yes

Returned from Executive Session and resumed Open Session at 8: 53 p.m.
