Meeting called to order at 7:23PM.

7:30 Appointment: John Wilder – Eagle Scout/Life Scout in Troop 53 Plympton.
Mr. Wilder requested permission from the Selectmen to accept his project plan to:

- Overhaul of the small park along the Winnextuxet River in Plympton.
- Clear the grounds of sticks and leaves and trim overgrown brush.
- Preserve small path over the dam.
- Clean moss off of the picnic benches.
- Erect a small information board displaying history of the mills and any vegetation found in the area.
- Completion result will be a beautiful town park for all to enjoy.
