

PLYMPTON BOARD OF SELECTMEN
MINUTES
March 16, 2009

Attendees: Joseph Freitas, Barry DeCristofano, and John Henry
Meeting called to order at 6:00 PM

Selectmen met with Town Treasurer, Carolyn Northon for a few minutes. Ms. Northon reported that the Tax Attorney had to postpone her appointment with Selectmen due to the flu.

Corriera conditions will be reviewed at a later date.

On the recommendation of the Building Inspector, the Board voted to appoint Thomas Bouchard (of Kingston) as Assistant Plumbing Inspector until June 30th, 2009. Motion – Mr. DeCristofano, 2nd – Mr. Henry. Vote: 3-0-0

Ms. Sayles informed the Board that she will prepare a chronology of Plympton Cycles permits from the Town. The Selectmen suggested that Ms. Sayles contact the Zoning Enforcement Officer and the Zoning Board of Appeals.
