Meeting called to order at 7:25 PM

REPORTS:

Mr. DeCristofano will e-mail his comments to members of the Open Space and Recreation Commission regarding the Draft Plan. The Selectmen state the Plan is great.

Mr. Freitas reported that he will contact the Agricultural Commission with his comments regarding their Draft Guidelines.

Mr. Henry reported that a State organization "citizens for citizens" (through the Counsel on Aging) will offer a person to be available to work in the Town House and be paid by the State. A memo will be sent to all departments, including Library informing them of same.

Mr. Timothy Dempsey informed the Selectmen that he will file a formal complaint to the Zoning Enforcement Officer and ask that any sign violations be addressed at the following businesses in Town: Kate's Sweet Shop, Plympton Mobil & Convenience, and Plympton Liquors & Convenience.

Mr. Henry asked Mr. Dempsey to continue his research on the 43D at the Industrial Park and permitting processes. Mr. Dempsey will contact Dick Gauley and the Old Colony Planning Council to follow up with the Boards request.

Mr. Henry noted that there will be a special election in January with the potential of a Special Town Meeting in early 2010.
