

PLYMPTON BOARD OF SELECTMEN
MINUTES
October 26, 2009

Attendees: Joseph Freitas, Barry DeCristofano, and John Henry
Meeting called to order at 7:00 PM

7:00 PM APPOINTMENT: Plymouth County Administrator, Troy B. G. Clarkson and Mr. Richard (Dick) Gauley. Mr. Clarkson outlined the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA). The Plymouth County region will receive:

- Fortytwo million dollars (\$42,000,000) in total.
- Seventeen million dollars (\$17,000,000) in economic development bonds.
- Twentyfive million dollars (\$25,000.000) in private sector facility bonds.

The federal government will make direct payments to bonding agencies for forty-five percent (45%) of interest costs on borrowing linked to "job creation and economic recovery."

The program is in the early stages of development. An Application and Guidance will be forthcoming next week. There are seven active Counties in this program. If one should decide not to apply, the pool of bonds will increase. One of the criteria being that the loans must be made by January 2011. Mr. Gauley will forward this information to the SNS Business Developer (Industrial Park.)

The Selectmen will await the "Application and Guidance" package due next week and will continue the process for consideration in the program.
