

PLYMPTON BOARD OF SELECTMEN
MINUTES
November 30, 2009

Attendees: Joseph Freitas, Barry DeCristofano, and John Henry
Meeting called to order at 7:00 PM

Mr. DeCristofano reported that there was an Executive Session at 6:25 PM with the Town Zoning Enforcement Officer to discuss his contract.

Mr. Tim Dempsey was recognized by the Selectmen at the meeting. Mr. Dempsey asked for the Selectmen for their support and consider and appoint him to the Zoning Board of Appeals as an Alternate Member. There was some discussion as to the present appointments Mr. Dempsey holds on the Conservation Commission and the 43 D Coordinator for the Industrial Park permit process.

Mr. Dempsey stated that if there was a conflict of interest with time management that he would prefer to be appointed to Zoning Board of Appeals versus the 43 D Coordinator.

Mr. Freitas thanked Mr. Dempsey for the outstanding job that he does on the Conservation Commission, however, he will not support an appointment for the Zoning Board of Appeals at this time.

Mr. Dempsey stated that he has enough time since retirement from work and wants to take an active roll in Town.
